COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

APPROVAL OF TRAWL NET - INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

(Client Information Sheet: Version October 2017)

Regulation 71A(1) of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 2001 allows the chief executive of the Ministry for Primary Industries to approve the use of a trawl net (referred to as Net A) if satisfied that:

- it performs at least as well as certain other specified nets (referred to as Net B) in providing for the utilisation of fisheries resources while ensuring sustainability; and
- the use of the net is consistent with fisheries plans approved under the Fisheries Act 1996.

Regulation 71B provides for how the chief executive compares the performance of the nets assessing the following matters: species composition, size composition, impact on protected species, impact on benthic species; and any other matter considered relevant relating to ensuring sustainability and utilisation.

Regulation 71C allows the chief executive to issue a notice specifying certain technical details about the comparison between the new trawl net (Net A) and the existing net (Net B) must be made, and the information to be included in any application.

Variation

Regulation 71A(4) allows a person who has been given an approval for the use of a trawl net under 71A(1) to apply to the chief executive to vary one or more terms or conditions of an approval.

Costs

The fee payable in respect of an application for approval under regulation 71A(1), or an application under regulation 71A(4) to vary an approval, is \$150.65 (GST incl) per hour or part hour to process the application. MPI will invoice applicants after a decision is made on an application.
