New Zealand attended the 8th session of the TFAMR. Main outcomes of importance to NZ were:

- Over 300 delegates from the Codex task force for antimicrobial resistance met virtually during
 October 2021 complete work on the revised Code of practice to minimize and contain
 foodborne AMR and the draft Guidelines on integrated monitoring and surveillance of
 foodborne AMR.
- New Zealand has acted as one of the cochairs in writing the Guidelines for the monitoring and surveillance of foodborne AMR since work began on the document in 2016.
- Both documents have been sent to the Commission with the recommendation for adoption at step 8 (Code of practice to minimize and contain foodborne AMR) and step 5/8 (Guidelines on integrated monitoring and surveillance of foodborne AMR). CAC44 will meet November 8th-18th virtually.
