1 Microbiological Criteria required for Certificates of Analysis for processed foods

- (1) The Drug and Food Administration of Indonesia (BPOM) issued the regulation number 16 year 2016 – “*Microbiological Criteria for Processed Foods*”. This regulation stipulates the content and format that Certificates of Analysis (COAs) accompanying shipments of processed foods to Indonesia must adhere to.
- (2) The Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) has recently become aware that Indonesian officials appear to be now enforcing this regulation at the Indonesian border, resulting in delayed entry for shipments.
- (3) MPI has been informed that Certificates of Analysis (COAs) accompanying shipments to Indonesia must meet the requirements of, and be presented in the format stipulated by the new mandatory regulation. Failure to do so may result in delayed or denied access.
