Fisheries Electronic Monitoring on Vessels Regulations 2017: Technical Amendment

On 29 January 2019, Cabinet:

- noted that the Fisheries (Electronic Monitoring on Vessels) Regulations 2017 (the Regulations) came into force on 1 October 2018 and provide for a staged rollout of electronic monitoring of commercial fishing vessels using on-board cameras;
- noted that the Regulations cannot be practically complied with by commercial fishers because detailed requirements have not been set and suppliers are not geared up to provide equipment;
- agreed to amend the application date of the Regulations, as a holding position, to 1 August 2019 for the first three stages that are identified in schedule 1 of the Regulations;
- 4 s9(2)(f)
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Fisheries (Electronic Monitoring on Vessels) Amendment Regulations 2019 [PCO 21958/5.0];
- 6 **noted** that a waiver of the 28-day rule is sought:
 - 6.1 so that the Amendment Regulations can come into force before 31 January 2019 in order to avoid a situation where fishers cannot practically comply with legal obligations; and
 - on the grounds that the changes delay rather than impose any requirements on industry and avoid a compliance gap;
- agreed to a waiver of the 28-day rule so that the Amendment Regulations can come into force on 31 January 2019.
